Your dog is welcome at the Chablis Inn. Call us at 800.443.3490 to make your dog's reservation and any special arrangements. Our dog fee is \$25 for the first night and \$10 for the second night (additional nights are complimentary).

### eat:

There are many great area restaurants that allow dogs on their patios. For breakfast, try **BANK Café and Bar** at The Westin Verasa. At lunch, try **Angele**, along the Napa River. And for dinner, check out **Bistro Don Giovanni**, they have a resident cat, so be nice!
