**NAPA NATIVE**

If you prefer to see what the locals enjoy, here are some tips for a true Napa native experience.

*eat:*

In a town so famous for good food, where do the locals eat? For breakfast, **ABC Bakery**. At lunch, try **Gott's Roadside** – it's "tray gourmet" – or, on Fridays, the bar at **Rutherford Grill** to hang out with the local vintners and winemakers. For dinner, those in the know eat at the bar (not a table) at **Redd**. The bartenders will take great care of you, and they also have a fun cocktail list.

*drink:*

Visit **Steltzner Vineyard** for great varietals. Allison Steltzner will be happy to help, and owner Dick Steltzner knows a thing or two about the Valley!

*play:*

Try **Uva Trattoria** for jazz at night; a hike at the Veterans' Home; Bikram Yoga; or bocce ball in Yountville or St. Helena.

*pack:*

For the natives, the dress code is jeans and a simple shirt. Also, even the locals have been known to pull a camera out for a shot of a hot air balloon, so it's OK to bring one.
